The Grinch the spotlight. 2012, the Mayan legend says, "Time will cease as we know it..." will get support as Pluto, the god of Transformation, moves into Capricorn on January 26, 2008. If not, then many older people's lives change at this point and they don't do it willingly. Massive change and transformation will take place. It will be monumental in scope; not something little. Pluto gives plenty of warning, decades beforehand, so that when we hit age 62, it doesn't have to be something to be afraid of if we have been maturing, becoming broader and deeper as a human being. If we have been growing and changing all along, the gifts of Pluto at this age are incalculable. They can be worldly gifts of fame, fortune, success, or more inner gifts of knowing one's self or going through initiations and making that Phoenix-like transformation so that your oneness with Spirit is a living, daily joy.

If we want an example of what Pluto can do, let's look back when it entered the sign of Sagittarius January 17, 1994 and remained there until January 24, 2007. This was a thirteen year transit through the sign of religion. Does "religion" issues ring a bell? You have all seen the rise of the religious fanatic across the globe and it isn't just the terrorists using Islam to batter the world with their distorted beliefs. Religion has suddenly surged into every day life and has threatened to deluge the state, which is to be separated from

## ***HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE OF PLUTO IN CAPRICORN***

Looking at history from 456 BC to the present, Pluto has (roughly speaking) spent sixteen (roughly because it can be 12 years sometimes) years in Capricorn every 248 years of one orbit about the sun. For you history buffs, here are the dates that Pluto was in Capricorn and you can do a little historical sniffing around to see what was going on in that time frame and see how it may reflect on us today. Remember the old saying: what we don't learn from history, we are bound to repeat. And that is so true. As we look back in history, see if you note the parallels to our own society today to get a 'feel' for where Pluto is going to be working energetically in our lives.

I culled the internet for information on each of these periods. And, of course, the BC time frame is not going to have the wealth of information that our AD time frame does for obvious reasons.

Still, there are people and events in BC that we see mirroring in our AD period. It is a fascinating journey and I invite you to read through these gleanings (sources are noted) and see how they might be repeating themselves in the near future, but on another level because we have grown and evolved since the BC era in some ways.

A twelve to sixteen year period in Pluto's cycle embraces all levels and elements of our life. (The reason for the years of difference is the oblong elliptical orbit of Pluto. For example, the shortest amount of time is spent in Scorpio and Taurus because they are at the 'ends' of the oblong orbit). Pluto will be in Capricorn for sixteen years. ## BC

### *472-456 BC*

Great people born or came to power during Pluto in Capricorn.

Socrates was born in 469 BC with his Pluto in Capricorn. He was a Greek philosopher who got us to question our ethics and virtue. He was not a scientist but his use of questioning has helped lay the foundation of science even as we utilize it today. And he had a famous student, Plato, who went on to blaze his own trail in the world of philosophy.

Euripides, a famous Greek writer lived from 485-406 BC.

Democritus (470-380 BC) was another Greek philosopher and he expanded the concept of atoms as being the base of all form of matter. Through his observation, Democritus also said the Moon was like Earth in many ways and that the

Milky Way really consisted of stars.

### **History:**

470 BC the Carthaginians launched an expedition under Hanno to sail to the West in order to found new trading colonies. He took 60 ships and 30,000 men and women and sailed through the Straits of Gibraltar and sailed down the African coast. When you stop and think about this amazing feat so long ago--to sail out of the Mediterranean sea and go beyond into the 'unknown', Hanno was truly a brave explorer of his time.

### **Earth Changes:**

in 464 BC the Greek city of Sparta was leveled by an earthquake that killed at least twenty thousand people. When the trembling was over, only five houses remained standing. And, interestingly, slaves revolted at that time and ran into the countryside where they resisted recapture for three years.

### *224-230 BC*

Great people born or came to power during Pluto in Capricorn.

Archimedes, the Greek mathematician and engineer lived from 287-212 BC. He's well known in Geometry and developing machines of war. He is very well known for "Eureka, eureka!" (I have found it!) and this was in his finding the theory of buoyancy while taking a bath.

Eratosthenes of Cyrene (276-200 BC) was a Greek astronomer and mathematician. He is responsible for calculating the circumference of the Earth and developed a method for calculating all prime numbers known as "the sieve of Eratosthenes."

## Earth Changes:

224 BC A earthquake toppled the one hundred foot high bronze statue of Apollo, the Greek sun god, as it stood at the entrance to Rhodes. There was no way to re-erect this historical statute.

217 BC North African earthquake destroyed one hundred cities and killed an estimated fifty-thousand people with that tremblor.

## AD

### 24-40 AD

Great people born or came to power during Pluto in Capricorn.

**140-37:** Roman emperor Tiberius and Rome prospered and enlarged her ownership of other countries by defeating them and absorbing them into Roman culture.

**37-41:** Roman emperor Caligula also known as the 'mad emperor' and was called 'little boots' derisively by the Roman army. This man was a dictator of chilling proportions to Rome.

**History:** None recorded but that doesn't mean there wasn't some.

**Earth Changes:** None recorded but that doesn't mean there wasn't some.

### 272-298 AD

Great people born or came to power during Pluto in Capricorn.

**275:** St. Eutychian (275-283) a native of Tuscany is elected Papa of Rome. Some suggest he decreed that only beans and grapes could be blessed at mass.

**276:** Probus (276-282) is Caesar of the Roman Empire.

**283:** St. Gaius alias Caius (283-296) a Dal-

matian possible relative of Emperor Diocletian (284-305) resulting in a peaceful reign. Carinus and Numerian held co-rule of the Roman Empire.

**284:** Diocletian (284-305) is Caesar of the Roman Empire. He would kill thousands of Christians during his reign including Marcellinus (296-304) Papa of Rome. Tetrarchy is the co-ruler of the Roman Empire.

**296:** Marcellinus (296-304) is elected Papa of Rome. Athanasius (296-373) is elected Papa of Alexandria.

## History:

**287:** The first recorded Viking raids are on the Lower Rhine. The Viking era is traditionally considered as 789 – 1100 A.D.

**297:** Romans deal with the Picts of Great Britain.

**Earth Changes:** None recorded but that doesn't mean there wasn't some.

### 520-536 AD

Great people born or came to power during Pluto in Capricorn.

**520:** King Arthur defeats the Saxons and stops their advance in Great Britain

**523:** St. John 1 of Tuscany is elected bishop of Rome

**518-527:** Religious suppression/destruction: Emperor Justin resurrected old laws against heretics and persecuted Goths and Aryans. Their churches were seized. King Theodore of Italy who was a Goth and Arian ordered the bishop of Rome to order him to stop the persecutions. Religious suppression and change also touched the Cult of Isis (that had been worshipped for 5,000 years) was destroyed during Justinian's reign, plunging maternal/matriarchal worship into darkness and

saw the rise of patriarchy and the worship of male gods only from this time to the present.

**526:** John I, Bishop of Rome traveled to Constantinople but failed to stop the persecution of the Goth and Arian people and their belief system. The Italian King Theodore was imprisoned and he died.

**527:** Justinian, emperor of Constantinople unites all branches of the Christian church and to abolish all heresies. He closed the Academy of Athens which he saw as a pagan center. He repressed the Manichaens, Jews and Samaritans to a level of second class citizens. Justinian Code decreed that those who were not Catholic were demented and insane. and, heretics/pagans would have no place to worship. Justinian established civil marriage and created the natural law that such men are born free.

**527:** Sumer, once called the cradle of European civilization and Mesopotamia is lost to our historical memory as a great swamp covered the region.

**530:** Diosorus is elected Bishop of Rome. There is many politics at this time between Roman rule and the religious front taking on new power. The Roman senate is outraged by such unconstitutional behavior and they try to call the papacy fraudulent. But, it doesn't work and the Catholic church continues to rise in power and authority thanks to Emperor Justinian's heavy handedness toward all things pagan and anti-catholic.

**533:** John 22 is elected Bishop of Rome after months of intrigue, corruption and bribery.

## Earth Changes:

**526:** A quarter million people died in an earthquake May 29th in Antioch, Syria.

## 768-784 AD

Great people born or came to power during Pluto in Capricorn. None recorded but that doesn't

mean there wasn't some

## History:

**768:** The Lombards carry out a coup in Rome. They capture the Constantine bishop and elect their own Bishop, Philip. There is great political and religious intrigue during this period. The Constantine elected bishop of Rome is stripped of his papal office and has his eyes gouged out.

**769:** King Charlemagne comes to power. He hosts a synod that included thirteen Frankish bishops to restore canonical order. They condemned iconoclastic and approved veneration of images (anything pagan).

**770:** The Vikings displace the Celt-Pict people along coastal settlements of Ireland and Scotland

The Lombards refuse to hand over promised cities to Rome. This creates a breach between the Bishop of Rome and the Frankish Royal House. It also creates mortal foes.

**771:** Frankish King Charles (Austria, southern German, Netherlands, Belgium and France) subdues the Lombard in Italy all the way to Rome.

**772:** Ghana (Kumbi) (Ghana, Africa) is the Land of Gold. The kings of Ghana are considered the richest on earth.

**774:** The Franks defeat the Lombards. The Germanic-Saxon rebel against this conquest and baptism--and they are put down many times more by the Franks.

**774:** The "Donation of Constantine" is the forgery of the Roman Catholic church dated to 326. It includes the confirmation of the bishop of Rome over ALL Christians and the dogma of the Church. It was finalized in 774.

**782:** King Charles 1 has taken 4.5 thousand Germanic-Saxon prisoners and had them beheaded on the banks of the Aller river.

## *1016-1032 AD*

Great people born or came to power during Pluto in Capricorn. None recorded but that doesn't mean there wasn't some.

### **History:**

**1016:** Viking/Danish, Celt, Anglo and Saxon peoples joined under reign of Emperor Canute the Great (a Viking). England became part of the Viking northern empire.

**1016:** Benedict VIII, bishop of Rome formed alliance to defeat Arab invader in northern Italy.

**1019:** Byzantine halt rebels at Canne. Benedict VIII flees to Germany.

**1022:** Constantinople excommunicates Benedict. The synod of Pavia prohibits marriage for all clergy. The main reason is to protect church property. If the priests can't marry there's no will leaving anything to wife or children.

**1023:** Arabs have border warfare in central Spain.

**1024:** John XiX (Romanus) elected bishop of Rome due their bribery to the Church.

**1025:** Gudleif, Norse trader, discovers Icelander Bjorn Asbrandson somewhere along the coast of North America. Probably the first 'white men' to discover that continent--long before Columbus. Although St. Brendan (484-477) of Ireland heard another monk tell him of a land far to the west of Ireland. The saint took seven years to discover this land which is thought to be North America. If this is true, then he is the first European to discover this continent.

**1027:** Gascon Sancho William and Aquitanian William V under the Christian flag attack Moslem

Spain now controlled by King Sancho III of Navarre.

**1030:** Norman Vikings create a fortress at Aversa, Italy, near Naples.

**1031:** Emperor Knorad II forbids inheritance of fiefs by women (more of the patriarchy dominion working to disempower women in all ways).

**1032:** Religious chaos and politics in the Catholic church come to a head. Bishops to Rome come and go even to the tune of one of them being poisoned.

**Earth Changes:** None recorded but that doesn't mean there wasn't some.

## *1264 - 1280 AD*

Great people born or came to power during Pluto in Capricorn. None recorded but that doesn't mean there wasn't some.

### **History:**

**1264:** Kubli Khan rules largest empire in the history of the world. Even appointment in Europe must be approved by the great khan. Kubli marches on the Sung Empire, the last hold out to the Mongolian empire.

**1225-1274:** Thomas Aquinas creates a synthesis between Christian theology and Aristotelianism. Political power is natural, he says.

**1265:** First English Parliament

**1266:** Charles of Anjou, brother to King Louis IX of France seizes the crown of Sicily.

Scotland and Norway move to a treaty to end Viking occupation of Scotland.

**1267:** Kublai Khan founded Beijing, China.

**1268:** The invention of eyeglasses.

**1269:** Marco Polo says he spots Noah's Ark on Mt. Ararat, Turkey

**1270:** Holy Wars, the 7th and final led by King Louis IX of France to the Holy Land.

**1271:** Marco Polo establishes a direct trading route along the ancient routes to China.

Kubla Khan builds one thousand way stations along his great road between China and Europe

Last of the Christian Crusades against the Muslims. The Muslims recapture all the territory in Syria held by the Crusaders by 1291.

**1272:** King Edward I, King of England wants the rest of Britain under his control.

The Hapsburg family begins their long rule of the Arch duchy of Austria (1273-1806).

**1274:** Kubli Khan does not conquer Japan from South Korea because a storm at sea forced his fleet to retreat.

**1275:** Freedom of Speech is curtailed because of censure by Roman Catholics toward Thomas Aquinas (who was trying to connect Aristotle thinking to the Catholic religion). St. Thomas Aquinas believes women are defective by nature and not created in God's image (more reduction of the feminine by the patriarchy). He also puts forth the notion that women had to be punished for bringing sin into the world.

Yakub moves into Spain with his Moroccan army and burned Jerez and killed the inhabitants.

The Sung Empire falls to Mongol Kubli Khan. The Khan then proclaims himself emperor of China and starts the new Yuan Dynasty. Kubli creates a cast system in China with Mongolian people being the ruling class and the Sung people are the lowest class with the Chin and Hsi-Hsia being the middle class. He nationalized gold and silver coins and created paper currency, a banking system and

a centralized government that included China, Europe to the Pacific Ocean. Kubli also built a great navy for exploration and trade. He established the Mongolia-Persian Gulf route. Russians, Turks and Persian traders also came to establish trading houses with the mighty Kubli Khan.

**1278:** 278 Jews are hanged in London for clipping coins. Of course, Christians are just as guilty of the same offense but they are fined, not murdered. Religious prejudice.

**1279:** The Yuan dynasty (Mongol empire) has completed the conquest of China. The Sung Dynasty is eliminated.

**1280:** Mechanical clocks are invented.

## Earth Changes:

**1277:** A storm floods the country surrounding the Zuider Zee (Netherlands). The towns are submerged and it allows enemy troops to capture the flooded cities by boat.

## 1405-1433 AD

The Chinese from 1405 to 1433 made many trips to the Pacific Islands including New Zealand and Australia with 63 flag ships of 500 foot length and 200 foot width. The charts made their way to Europe.

## 1512 - 1528 AD

Great people born or came to power during Pluto in Capricorn:

Paracelsus (1493-1541) studied alchemy and chemistry at Basel University and learned the properties of metals and minerals in mines. His unorthodox mystical theories lost him the position of town physician of Basel (1526-1528), but through empirical experiment in pursuit of his dreams he made new chemical compounds and changed medicine and pharmacy.

Nicholas Copernicus (1473-1513) a Polish astronomer and mathematician shook the world order. He said the sun was the center of the solar system, not the earth. He also said orbits of planets were irregular. The Catholic church promptly banned his work for over 200 years. It should be noted he made the announcement while Pluto was in Aquarius, not Capricorn. However, all the work and thought were done with Pluto in Capricorn.

**1512-1528** philosopher from Italy Nicolo Machiavelli (1469-1527)

## ART:

**1500-1550:** The Danube School of German Painting and beautiful landscapes became the vogue.

**1450-1600:** Venetian School and was comprised of Renaissance artists, particularly painters who employed aspects of light and color.

**1500-1650:** Umbrian School was an Italian school of painting. This school emphasized perspective and geometric composition as well as modeling figures and objects by means of light and color.

**1513:** Urs Graf invents etching.

**1516:** Raffael paints The School of Athens

**1520-1600:** The school of Mannerism art flourishes. It is an art style that focused on the human form, depicted in intricate poses and in exaggerated, not always realistic settings.

## History:

**1512:** Anti-pope Julius II Holy Roman League army is severely defeated at Ravenna but the arrival of the Spanish and Swiss army forced the French to quit Italy.

**1513:** Henry VIII (1509-1547) army destroyed the Scottish army at Flodden, and James IV, mar-

ried to Henry's daughter Margaret is killed along with twenty Scottish nobles. Henry would also march against James V who is badly defeated and died shortly there after.

A Turkish map of the world includes South America, West Indies, and Africa includes a note how a Genoese infidel Columbo pestered the Spanish king for ships.

Leo X alias Giovanni de Medici (**1513-1521**) a commander in the papal army is elected pope some say without the use of simony. His objective is to make Spanish-Italy and his own Florence free from foreign domination and to advance his family influence outside Florence.

**1514:** Pope Leo X (1513-1521) renewed the system of sale of indulgence for the reconstruction of St. Peter's.

King Ferdinand (1479-1516) of Spain forbid the publication of any papal bull or rescript in Spain without preliminary examination by the Royal Council and without Royal approval. .

Selim I the Turk defeated the Persians (Iran) and in 1515 conquered Armenia and Kurdistan.

**1515:** Francis I (1515-1547) defeated the Vatican's Holy Roman League at Marignano recovering Milan for France

**1516:** Syria fell to the Turkish army this year as the Ottoman Empire expanded south toward Egypt. The first Jewish quarter to be called a Ghetto is created in Venice about this time.

Charles I (Hapsburg) of Ghent (1500-1558) a Flemish boy raised in Flanders became King of Spain.

**1517:** The publication of Luther's ninety-five theses became the official launch of protestant christianity. The Bible was given priority over the church as the source of authority. The scope for religious disagreements multiplied as more and

more people were able to read it for themselves. The movement for the reform of the Catholic (universal) church and the breakaway of protestant and reformed churches is called The Reformation.

Turkey occupied Egypt and the Holy places of Mecca. Sultan Selim I take control of Jerusalem, yet very few Ottoman Turks settle in the city. They pressed on taking Algeria by 1519.

A number of cardinals plotted to poison Pope Leo X (1513-1521) and their leader Alfonso Petrucci is executed and several others are imprisoned. Pope Leo then packed the sacred college by creating 31 new cardinals.

Martin Luther (**1483-1546**) on October 31 at the castle church of Wittenberg, Germany, the Saxon professor of divinity posted his ninety-five theses or arguments calling for a disputation on the abuses of the traffic in indulgences.

**1518 - SLAVERY:** License to import 4,000 African slaves to Spanish American Colonies is granted to Lorenz de Gominot.

**1519:** Hernando Cortes begins assault on Mexico, defeats the Aztecs

Cortes brings Arabian horses to Americas from Spain

Domenico de Pineda explores Gulf of Mexico from Florida to Vera Cruz

Emperor Charles V (Hapsburg) of Ghent (**1500-1558**) a Flemish boy King of Spain is elected Holy Roman Emperor on the death of his grandfather Maximilian. The Spanish people revolted against the Flemish rule and they're absent king. The revolt lasted until 1522.

**1520:** Magellan navigates through the straits from Atlantic to Pacific

Pope Leo X (**1513-1521**) (Giovanni de Medici) condemned Martin Luther (**1483-1546**) the

German for daring to say that burning heretics is against the will of God, amongst other things unless he recant. Luther appealed to a General Council and for twenty-five years the Pope and Curia refused the appeal to the only forum capable of settling the grave issues in the church. Pope Leo is the great uncle of Catherine de Medici, future Queen of France.

King Christian II of Denmark and Norway defeated a Spanish army at Lake Asunden and was crowned King of Sweden. He then renounced his offer for Amnesty and massacred most of the Swedish leaders, about 600 nobles.

**RUTHLESS DESTRUCTION OF OTHER CULTURES:** The Aztec Emperor, Montezuma II, is dead. The Spanish are considered the Bastille of Roman Christianity with a mandate to subject the Americans for Spain, the Papacy and the Roman Catholic Church.

Chocolate was brought from Mexico to Spain for the first time.

**BOOK BURNING** on October 7: The first public burning of books took place in Louvain, Netherlands.

**1521:** Martin Luther excommunicated from the Roman Catholic Church, Jan 3 but the papal nuncio in Germany reported nine tenths of all Germans cried Luther and the other tenth cried death to Pope Leo.

Guam, where America's day begins, explored by Magellan

Belgrade (Beograd), Yugoslavia fell to Turkey as the Ottoman Empire expanded into Europe under command of Sultan Suleyman I the Magnificent (1520-1566). Hungary is threatened and Rhodes is besieged.

Ferdinand Magellan, a Portuguese, died April 27, 1521, he had renounced his citizenship and joined the Spanish

The Spanish conquistador Hernan Cortes attacked Tenochtitlan, Mexico killing 100,000 Aztecs

**1522:** Pope Hadrian VI alias Adrian Florensz Dedal (1522-1523) an inquisitor for Aragon and Navarre in 1516, inquisitor for Castile and Leon 1518 is elected pope.

Pope Hadrian had condemned Martin Luther as inquisitor in Spain and believed he should be punished for heresy and his teachings banned.

The Island of Rhodes (Greece) fell to the Turkish advance.

England declared war on France and Scotland.

September 8, Juan Sebastian del Cano d-1526, of Spain is the first to circumnavigate the world returning to Spain this year.

**1523:** Martin Luther (1483-1546) spoke out in defense of the Jews saying that our Lord Jesus Christ was born a Jew. He also argued that the Letters of St. James the Just, Brother of Jesus should not be included in the New Testament.

The first burning of heretics of the Christian Reformation took place at Brussels this year under the reign of Pope Clement VII (1523-1534).

**1524:** Giovanni da Verrazano explores Hudson River and New York harbor waters

**GENOCIDE & RELIGION** - The peasants of Germany, about 250,000 from the Black Forest on July 19, 1524 revolted demanding the right to select their preacher, the abolition of tithes and slavery, the right to hunt and fish where they pleased, etc. May 15, 1525 the revolt is put down when one hundred thousand peasants' martyrs are killed in a blood bath. When Bishop Conrad recaptures Wurzburg, the event is celebrated with 64 executions. He then toured his diocese with his executioner who took care of another 272 people.

Francis I of France (1515-1547) re-conquered

Milan and Pope Clement VII aligned with France and Venice against Emperor Charles V (1500-1558) of Spain.

**1525:** The church controlled Salzburg castle is attacked by revolting peasants but they fail to breach the castle walls.

Martin Luther (**1483-1546**) married the former nun Katherine Von Bora having previously rejected celibacy.

In Spain a royal edict ordered all pasture lands brought under tillage during the first eight years of the Emperors reign be restored to its original state and placed at the disposal of sheep-farmers. Agriculture is considered the lowest form of occupation. Gentlemen and Catholics don't till the land.

The Anabaptist movement started in Zurich, Switzerland. They rejected infant baptism, forbid violence, divorce and materialism as described in the Bible. They also considered Holy Communion as the "Bread of Idolatry".

Charles V issues an edict in Holland ordering all those that call themselves Egyptians (Gypsy) to leave the country within two days.

William Tyndale's The New Testament in English printed in Germany and shipped into England against official hostility

**1526:** Spanish attempt colonization of Cape Fear; it lasts only a few months

Henry VIII (**1509-1547**) is married to Catherine of Aragon.

Pope Clement alias Cardinal Giulio de Medici is born a bastard some say with a cold and dry heart. He is unable to juggle the rival ambitions of the growing national powers of Europe. Some suggest he attempted to perpetuate the dying Medici line through his bastard sons Alessandro and Lorenzo from a Moorish slave. Catherine de Medici

his niece is also being considered to enhance his position. He made a fundamental error when he created the Holy League of Cognac uniting the French and numerous Italian Princes against Emperor Charles V (1500-1558) of the Holy Roman Empire that included Spain and Italy.

As the Pope wages war against the Holy Roman Empire Turkey is quietly invading from the east up the Danube valley. Turkey defeated Hungary in the battle of Mohacs then turned toward Vienna. A plague visited Rome this year.

The slave trade has escalated to the point where Portuguese bribed officials to revolt and provide goods and guns to any chief who would supply slaves.

**PREJUDICE** - The first anti-Gypsy laws are passed in Holland and Portugal.

**1527:** Charles V (**1500-1558**), the Holy Roman Emperor (**1519-1556**) sent an army of 20,000 mercenaries mostly Germans and Spaniards against Rome. The city is put to the most terrible sacking for revolting against the Holy Empire. Pope Clement VII (**1523-1534**) is made a prisoner for six months.

The Holy Roman Emperor and Henry VIII (**1509-1547**) of England had agreed to divide up France giving the Duke a significant share. . Rome declared itself a republic and proceeded to rid itself of all vestiges of the loathed Medici name. They again encouraged the French to invade Spanish Italy.

Niccolo Machiavelli died and his book 'The Prince' is published. Vice and evil became respectable providing it was done for political or religious purposes.

Hernando Cortes brought back to Spain tomatoes, avocados, papayas and Vanilla from New Spain. The tomato was not an early success story as its acid content reacted with pewter plates, leaching out the lead, causing lead poisoning,

leading to death.

**November 20:** Wendelmoet Weyntjen Claesdochter, became the first known Dutch woman to be burned as a heretic.

**1528:** Panfilo de Narvaez invades Florida from Cuba, wars with Indians.

Copernicus finished a book arguing that the earth goes round the sun, not the sun round the earth. The first printed copy was in 1543.

Gypsy (Roma) are first recorded in Sweden on 29 September.

The great Genoese Admiral Andre Doria deserted the French bringing with him his republic and it great fleet into Spanish dependency. Spain again marched against Italy driving the French from their short-term gains.

## Art:

**Neoclassicism - (1750 - 1830).** The term Neoclassicism refers to the classical revival in European art, architecture, and interior design that lasted from the mid-eighteenth to the early nineteenth century. This period gave rebirth to the art of ancient Rome and Greece and the Renaissance as an opposition to the ostentatious Baroque and Rococo art that preceded the movement.

## History:

Piston steam engines had been used to pump water since the end of the 17th century. In the 1760s, James Watt created more powerful engines by condensing

the steam in a vessel separate from the cylinder. These made steam engines an alternative to water wheels, and moved industry from the side of highland streams to lowland coalfields.

King George III (1760-1820) made peace with France without informing King Frederick II (1740-1786) of Prussia leaving them to fight France alone. The Treaty of Paris clearly established the principle that the French had no right to give away Indian property, by treaty or otherwise. A mandate from the crown of England made it clear that possession of Indian Lands is to be acquired by fair purchase and then by governments and not individuals.

**1764:** Voltaire Publishes Dictionnaire philosophique.

Repeated offences by men result in the galleys for nine years, and in several repeat offences, in perpetuity.

Pope Clement XIII refused to back down on what he considered Catholic dogma of church over state and suffered a stroke and died. Some believed that God struck him down for his and the Jesuit arrogance.

In the coming era of Pluto in Capricorn, we should expect some mind boggling, useful inventions to appear. They will have to do with manufacturing, travel (space ships, faster planes, cars that work on hydrogen or some other green 'gas'), space ships, a new source of clean energy, medical breakthroughs (genetics, cloning), computer revolutions used by millions (think of the Apple people gone wild here and we thought the Ipod and Iphone were something? Just wait! Apple is ultimately the most practical and visionary in computers today and will bloom under this Pluto in Capricorn era).

## RELIGION:

As you can see through history, it has been about one upsmanship of one religion destroying or trying to destroy others. And then manipulating the materials so that gospels are rewritten or chosen to show a certain way that people are to believe--never mind it's not the whole truth of what is written in other gospels. Patriarchal ways of living have thrived for the last three thousand years. Before that, it was a matriarchal existence. It was during the 17th and 18th centuries that science was separate out from religion. This was a huge step considering the Church had a deathgrip on people from Roman times forward to that time. Considering the Church has gone through horrible sex scandals, religion is no longer seen as having lily white hands they'd like us to believe. We are going to see rebellion in religions--all of them--on a large

or small scale.

With the advent of Mohammed, Confucius, Jesus, and other males who are now considered the right gender to deliver us truths in what we are to believe, perhaps the turn will evolve to bring a few women up to the top who may help us perceive a different venue and way of believing. Or, at least applying what we're supposed to be practicing daily. A woman religious writer or minister may show us a different way that does not mean war, or saying that another religion is wrong or not as good as the one you believe in. With males running the religious ship we can see historically it has brought only war. And now, in today's scope, it has brought us terrorism with one of the older male religions bashing one another: Islamic terrorists hating Christians. We had the Crusades and now, we are having them again in a slightly different way and expression. And even if you don't agree with that statement what we can agree on is that it springs from a religious source run by men.

Religious upheaval took place through Martin Luther who overthrew the Catholic yoke and started Protestantism. We may well have another upheaval in the Catholic church. How about priests can marry and have a family? Women become priests? The Catholic church comes clean and admits that Mary Magdalene was Jesus' wife? The veneration of women rises within the Catholic church instead of being seen as the root of all evil? We already see fractures in the Church of England when it comes to homosexuals; those who can tolerate such a way of being vs. those who cannot and the splintering of the church as a result. More of this will occur in many other religions.

And even more provocative: What if a woman rises to power and starts a NEW female religion with a female goddess that rivals "god" of the organized religions we have today? Heifer.org is a wonderful website where you can see common sense in action--a show and tell--to help those less fortunate get back on their feet with humanity and dignity. This is truly a Pluto in Capricorn organization way ahead of its time and I predict that any organization like Heifer who emulates their success, will soar and grow during this coming transit.

## **Food:**

I believe we are going to see a massive resurgence of everyone growing their own gardens or having farmer co-ops. People are tired of being poisoned by the food they eat. Just as there were "victory gardens" where the USA urged all inhabitants to have their own gardens because of food shortages due to world war 2, we will again have gardens. Green gardens. ## ***PLUTO AND HOW IT ASPECTS YOUR CHART*** ***by Grace Verte***

Pluto is the planet that adds depth, strength or power, intensity or obsession, will and insight to any planet which it contacts. Pluto is the planet of transformation. Transformation means change, which is a death of something so that a rebirth can take place. It is never easy, but we can learn to direct and guide our inner energies to the highest good for our own growth and for all those around us.

We can use our Plutonian energies to find lost objects, hidden memories, and deeply buried secrets. We can also learn to work with anything underground, such as oil, ducts, subways, and sewers. Nothing is sacred or too disturbing for Plutonian energies to tackle.

If we consider our presence here on Earth as an opportunity for soul growth, then Pluto's energies are best used by swimming with the current. Wherever Pluto makes an aspect to your chart, that area is intensified. If we allow it, and go with the flow, deep transformation can take place there. We can learn to transform demanding attitudes in ourselves. That is the first law of astrology: to transform self, not others.

Hard aspects with which I will deal here are the conjunction, when the planets are within 8 degrees of each other; the square, when the planets are at a 90 degree angle to each other; the inconjunct, also called a quincunx, when the planets are 150 degrees apart; and the opposition, when the planets are 180 apart. The planets represent the energies that are operating in our lives. The personal planets which I will juxtapose to Pluto here are the Sun, the Moon, Mercury, Venus, and Mars.

### **CONJUNCTIONS**

When Pluto conjuncts our Sun your will is intensified and you have strong leadership qualities. Our work will be to learn not to impose our will on that of others. To be open about our motives and our goals, despite the secrecy under which Pluto likes to operate. Other people are not fooled, only our leadership would suffer.

If Pluto conjuncts our Moon it adds power to our emotions. At times, especially when we are young, this can lead to intense feelings, of going overboard with emotional reactions, and therefore being out of control.

If there is anything Pluto hates, it is feeling out of control. Pluto asks us to deal with our control

issues in this area of emotions. Emotions are often held too much in check, and we must learn that we can express ourselves calmly and warmly.

This position also often translates into being very hard workers in order to overcome being overcome by emotions. The Moon also rules motherhood, nurturing, and dependencies which may never have been satisfactorily resolved during childhood. Since we didn't know what to do with these feelings then, we have an opportunity as adults to allow them up to awareness, in order to deal with them now.

When Pluto conjuncts our Mercury the focus is on communication. We may come on too strong, and expect others to abide by our opinions. With this placement we can contact the deep parts of our Self, solve mysteries, and allow into our consciousness what others may commonly sweep or keep under the rug. It is also possible to have strong disagreements and even breakups with our siblings. Thinking in circles or obsessing about a subject or a person is not uncommon. This ability to think deeply about things can be used positively by delving into the esoteric mysteries of life.

When Pluto conjuncts your Venus the intensity is focused on our creativity and our relationships. In the areas of values we need to transform our feelings of self-worth, of possessions and possessiveness into a more relaxed and self-accepting attitude. The power of Pluto is often exercised in love relationships, so that we have the opportunity and the power to resolve them into sharing and tolerance.

When Pluto conjuncts our Mars our power seems doubled. We may be faced with issues of self-assertiveness vs.. aggression and deeply buried anger. The sheer force of our will can then cause us to become ruthless because we can so easily overlook everyone in our drive to achieving our ambitions and goals in our life. But our anger and aggressive feelings can be directed into responsible leadership qualities, our fears can be turned into courage and risk taking when needed.

## SQUARES

Pluto squaring the Sun signals internal conflict to bring about change in the way we express areas that serve our sense of who we are. The Sun rules the will, the spirit and our individuality. Here the transformation is to allow our true self to come to the surface in order to release any negative attitudes, and to transform inner stress associated with the square to the Sun.

When Pluto squares the Moon we are faced with emotional turmoil beneath the surface, usually held in check by Plutonian will and power. When they erupt, it is like a volcanic force erupting. Here we need to learn to trust ourselves to govern our emotions. We also need to learn to trust others, especially in relationships. We also have an uncanny ability to tune in to mass consciousness with this placement, as the Moon also rules the public when it is ruled by emotions, not reason.

With Pluto squaring Mercury, it challenges our mind to learn to keep an open mind where the opinions of others are concerned - we might even enlarge our own "knowledge" base. The difficulty to be overcome here is to learn to trust our own knowledge, and that of others as well.

Pluto squaring Venus indicates that we are to learn to transform our values, be they material, mental, emotional or spiritual. Holding on to our old ways is out and the path to transforming our sense of self-worth, ideas (ours and theirs), possessions and friends, is through relationships. It is often through a crisis of resentments and jealousies that will come up from our inner turmoil that we get the opportunity for it to be resolved.

Pluto squaring Mars asks us to deal with problems around self-assertiveness, anger, and to learn to control our energies. Others' energies are usually not a match for our unceasing, goal-oriented energies, and we need to be less demanding of others in our attitudes toward them. To keep all these activities from depleting us, we need to be aware that we need periodic rests.

## **INCONJUNCTS (QUINCUNX)**

Pluto inconjunct (qux = symbol in next paragraphs) the Sun. The sun is the source of our vitality. Pluto here causes a disruptive need for ego gratification and/or recognition at all costs. When we bring Plutonian energies to the surface, as in becoming aware of them, we thereby defuse their power and intensity. We can then allow them to play their supportive role in our life.

Pluto qux the Moon describes our habit patterns. Pluto's best use in this aspect is to learn discernment where our feelings are concerned. While it is necessary to bring our very intense feelings up to our awareness, we then need to find a satisfactory and safe outlet for them. A transformation of our habitual responses to our feelings may be the answer.

With Pluto qux Mercury our thinking abilities are deep, but if used to confuse people with words, and to keep them in awe of our ability to use uncommon words, we are missing our potential. This is a good placement for writing mysteries and for doing research.

When Pluto is qux Venus it often skews our ability to appraise values correctly. We may have a mistaken view of people, such as hidden enemies who pose as friends, or of our own self-worth. We need to learn to let go of possessiveness and jealousy over people and material things.

Pluto qux Mars asks us to learn to adjust our wills so as to allow others their way too, and to use our courage in bringing about inner change in ourselves.

## **OPPOSITIONS**

When Pluto opposes our Sun it can goad us into opening up to new visions of ourselves. What we need to transform is our ego, our will, and our stubbornness. Love heals all and Pluto gives us the strength to make these changes. With loving

hearts and Plutonian power together we can love ourselves back into our original unity.

With Pluto in opposition to our Moon deep feelings of possessiveness or jealousy will surface, and we are susceptible to great emotional mood swings. Our emotions are deep and difficult to control with this position. Here we can learn to allow ourselves the freedom to feel what we feel, and to allow others the same freedom.

With Pluto opposing Mercury we can be very intolerant to others' ideas and beliefs. It can bring about a crisis of faith for us. We may project our anger by speaking about things better left unsaid. Or we may intimidate people into avoiding any discussions with us.

We need to learn to rein in the deep and passionate power behind our words, and to tolerate dissension. When Pluto is in opposition to our Venus we need to learn to temper our possessiveness and jealousy, and to check our need to control others, as we also need to learn to not allow anyone to control us. Here we are faced with a transformation of values, physical, emotional, mental, or spiritual.

The Pluto Mars opposition gives us the opportunity to learn to interact with others in a harmonious way. With this placement we are very ambitious and intense and goal oriented. This doubled energy of Mars and Pluto can easily turn into stubbornness if we don't consciously make the effort to listen to or to try out ideas of others.
